

Volunteer Militia Cavalry, Kingdom of Hawai'i

First Hawaiian Cavalry Honolulu Cavalry Troop Puali Kaua Lio o Honolulu

1861-1874

Original **First Hawaiian Cavalry** established December 17, 1852, following the Sailors Riot (**stood down 1856**)

Re-Organized/Re-Established November 1861 as the **First Hawaiian Cavalry** (including the Honolulu Cavalry troop)—an *integrated* (Native Hawaiian + Haole) corps, 70+ members

Requested and received permission, 1862, to appoint **Ka Haku o Hawai'i (The Prince of Hawai'i)** the rank of **Honorary Corporal**

SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

April 17, 1862 – First full-dress mounted parade, tournament, and banquet - H.R.H., Corporal Albert Edward Kauikeaouli Kaleiopapa in Hawaiian Cavalry uniform is mounted and rides with the corps throughout the day

May 2, 1862 – Royal Escort, opening of the National Legislature

May 20, 1862 – Prince of Hawai'i's birthday, holiday and celebration – Presentation of National Colors (i.e., Regimental Standard) to the Hawaiian Cavalry by H.M. Queen Emma

July 31, 1862 – Restoration Day parade, training & tournament

August 28, 1862 – Official mourning begins for the Prince of Hawai'i. King Kamehameha IV orders the construction of the Royal Mausoleum to rest the body of Prince Albert

Nov 28, 1862 – Royal Escort (Episcopal Confirmation of King Kamehameha IV and Queen Emma) / Anniversary of Anglo-French Recognition (Hawaiian Independence)

Nov 30, 1863 – Obsequies, passing of H.M. King Kamehameha IV

Feb 3, 1864 – Reinterment (Funeral) of King Kamehameha IV and the Prince of Hawai'i at Mauna 'Ala

Feb 27, 1874 – Hawaiian Cavalry are **disbanded** following the Election (or "Courthouse") Riot
